- **Size:** Length 255 ft with a beam of 64 ft

- **Route:** The Island Home is serving the route between Woods Hole and Vineyard Haven

- **Vehicle Capacity:** The freight deck can accommodate 60 vehicles with an additional 16 on hydraulic lift decks, for a total capacity of 76 vehicles. The freight deck can be configured to hold motor coaches, trucks or semi-trailers.
- **Powered by** two EMD diesel engines delivering a total of 6000 hp, and it has a top speed of 16 knots
